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LIBRARY IN NUMBERS: THE HANDWRITTEN CATALOGUE OF THE GARELLI'S BOOK COLLECTION 1774–1778

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The article provides the statistical analysis of publications in the handwritten catalogue (1774–1778) of the Garelli's book collection which belonged to Pius Nicolaus Garelli (1670–1740) and his son Johann Baptist Hannibal Garelli (1720–1741). This catalogue was arranged by Michael Denis, the keeper of this collection in Theresian Academy in Vienna. This is the last one from the known library catalogues composed before the collection was passed to Lviv University Library in 1784. Moreover, the classification of books in this collection by Michael Denis was reproduced in the article.

The Scientific Library of Lviv Ivan Franko National University is the oldest library in Ukraine and dates back to the beginning of the XVIII century. It was founded as the Jesuit Collegium and School Library and in 1661–1773 functioned as the library of the Jesuit University. After the elimination of the Society of Jesus in 1773 and the further reestablishment of Lviv University by Kaiser Joseph II in 1784¹, the Jesuit library became the basis for a new state educational institution².

Besides the Jesuit book collection, the library of Lviv University was enriched with books from the monasteries dissolved on the territories of the Kingdom of Halychyna and Lodomeria in the course of secular reforms (till nowadays funds

of the Scientific Library contain several handwritten inventories from these libraries³ plus manuscripts).

The private collection of Pius Nicolaus Garelli (1670–1740), the counselor of Emperor Charles VI, Prefect of the Imperial Court Library, archiater, and bibliophile, and his son, a doctor and bibliophile as well, Johann Baptist Hannibal Garelli (1720–1741) is another part that formed the University Library at the end of the XVIII century.

They bequeathed their private collection to be moved to the Imperial Court Library while 10000 florins were to be spent on buying new books and maintaining the collection⁴. However, their collection was connected to the library of Theresian Academy and afterwards, following the decision of Emperor Joseph II, was conveyed to Lviv University. Heinrich Gottfried von Bretschneider (1739–1810) was assigned to deliver it to Lviv. He also became the first director of the University Library in Lviv and remained on this position till 1801⁵. He was assisted by Pr. Martin Kuralt (1757–1845) who held the position of the keeper in 1784–1801 and 1805–1809⁶.

In such a way at the end of the XVIII century the library of the Austrian bibliophiles had already undergone several stages: establishment and functioning in the Garelli family; maintenance in the Imperial Court Library (1741–1748); storage in Theresian Academy (1748–1784); moving to Lviv and functioning as a part of the University Library (from 1784). These stages are documented in the form of handwritten catalogues⁷.

The period when the collection was in Theresian Academy is recorded in five catalogues of Erasm Fröhlich, the first keeper of the library in Theresianum, as well as in the two-volume catalogue of Josef Kell, his successor⁸. The last known catalogue was arranged by the Emperor's counselor, keeper of the Imperial Court Library, and bibliographer Michael Denis (1729–1800), who took care of the Garelli's book collection from 1773⁹. This is a seven-volume catalogue of books from the Garelli's collection organized in 1774–1778.

Unfortunately, the researchers of the history of the University Library in Lviv practically did not research this collection and the facts established in the XIX century are widely used in the modern scientific community. Ludwik Finkel, one of those who wrote the first history of Lviv University described the Garelli's book collection as the basic core of this library as the Jesuit collection could not fulfill the demands of "educated people"¹⁰. Anna Jędrzejowska who worked in the University Library during the interwar period also considered this collection to be the foundation of the academic library, yet she put an emphasize on its "German character" and called it "alien to the general public"¹¹. Modern researchers of the University Library history and the role of the Garelli's collection in its organization use the work of these two scholars, Finkel and Jędrzejowska, as well as of several other pre-war writers as their basis¹².

Pretty much the best studies of the book collection in question belong to Natalia Shvets¹³. However, the researcher practically doesn't study the Garelli's library from the quantitative perspective. It is generally accepted in historiography that this library includes 11000 volumes. Yet, it is important to remember that according to the last will of Johann Baptist Hannibal Garelli, 10000 florins were supposed to be spent on the proper maintenance of this collection and purchases of new books¹⁴. Therefore, it is obvious that after being connected with the Imperial Court Library and later Theresarium, Garelli's collection was supplied with new publications. Due to this fact, the usage of the last handwritten catalogue to define the quantitative character of this book collection before it was passed to Lviv University seems appropriate.

The catalogue in question was arranged by Michael Denis in 1774–1778 while Antoni Schneider was the scribe¹⁵. The catalogue consists of seven volumes and each of them is dedicated to a separate "general" science: theology, law, philosophy, medicine, mathematics, history, and philology. Describing the catalogue,

Natalia Shvets relies on the work of Michael Denis – “Grundriss der Bibliographie” (Vienna, 1777). The scholar characterizes the catalogue: “Every volume is dedicated to a separate basic discipline and ends with the so-called “interdisciplinary sciences” which connect different primary disciplines”¹⁶. Although the manuscript didn’t include ciphers, the correspondences of modern inventory numbers (Natalia Shvets highlighted them in her attempts to restore Garelli’s library), it gives the possibility to not only reveal the number of book in the library before its “journey” to Lviv, but also study the library organization in the XVIII century¹⁷.

It is worth mentioning that the books were written in the catalogue already after its arrangement in 1778. With the help of “additional” book records that were presumably made not by Antoni Schneider but a different scribe, it can be easily traced. Inscriptions made in Polish should be also pointed out. They were made in the seventh catalogue by Michael Denis. The last subgroup, “Varia”, includes books from different fields. The same inscription is duplicated beneath in Polish – “ROZMAITOSCI”¹⁸.

In the 1930s a prominent researcher, Anna Jędrzejowska, the head of the Department of Manuscripts and Old Printed Books in the University Library from 1925, studied this catalogue¹⁹. This is also proved by red (incunabula) and blue (Polonica) pencil marks in different volumes of Denis’s catalogue. In addition, at the beginning of every volume, the number of incunabula and Polonica are indicated.

In general, more than 15000 books were written to the handwritten catalogue of the Garelli family which was kept at Theresian Academy in Vienna at that time. It contradicts with the common number of 11000 books that reached Lviv University. Apparently, between 1741 (death of Johann Baptist Hannibal Garelli) and 1784 (the order of the Emperor to move the library to Lviv), it was enriched by new books as was bequeathed in the last will of Johann Baptist Hannibal Garelli.

The below-mentioned tables include information about the thematic division of the Garelli’s book collection and its numerical aspect from all the seven themes in accordance with the catalogue of 1774–1778 by Michael Denis.

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КНИГОЗБІРНЯ У СВІТЛІ ЧИСЕЛ: РУКОПИСНИЙ КАТАЛОГ БІБЛІОТЕКИ ГАРЕЛЛІ 1774–1778 рр.

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У статті проведено статистичний аналіз книг, внесених до рукописного каталогу 1774–1778 рр. книгозбірні Пія Ніколауса Гареллі (1670–1740) та його сина Йоганна Баптиста Ганнібала Гареллі (1720–1741). Каталог уклав хранитель цієї бібліотеки у віденській Терезіанській академії Міхаель Деніс. Це останній з відомих каталогів бібліотеки, що створений до передання цієї колекції до книгозбірні Львівського університету у 1784 р. Також детально відтворено здійснену Міхаелем Денісом систематизацію книг у бібліотеці.
